



Saltillo High School Distance Learning Guidelines

- **All classes will follow Mississippi Department of Education College and Career Readiness Standards.**
- **Distance Learning and On-Campus students will follow the same standards and work at the same pace. This will allow for a smooth transition if a student moves from on enrollment status to another. It will also make it easier for teachers to provide quality instruction.**
- **Delivery of instruction will take place mainly through the use of Google Classroom.**
- **Online videos, texts, and resources may be used as well as textbooks for instruction.**
- **Teachers will be available Monday through Friday from 2:00-4:00 to answer questions for Distance Learners, or at a scheduled time worked out between the teacher and Distance Learner.**
- **Distance Learners may have to report to school at a scheduled time for proctored tests. Teachers will set up the times when Distance Learners are to report. The proctored tests will be scheduled Monday through Friday from 2:00-4:00, or at a scheduled time worked out between the teacher and Distance Learner. Distance Learners will have to provide their own transportation to and from campus.**
- **The same grading scale will be used for both Distance Learning and On-Campus Students. The grading scale will be the traditional Lee County School District scale which can be found in the Student Handbook.**
- **Distance Learning will be for a minimum of 9 weeks and must be updated at the end of each 9 week period.**
- **Students must log onto the Google Classroom daily for attendance to be taken.**
- **Students that wish to participate in extracurricular activities or athletics should seek the guidance of their coach, sponsor, or director as to the guidelines for participation in the sport or activity of which they are wishing to participate.**
