



Distance Learning

Guidelines

- All classes will follow Mississippi Department of Education College and Career Readiness Standards.
- Distance Learning and Traditional students will follow the same standards and work at the same pace. This will allow for a smooth transition if a student moves from one track to the other. It will also make it easier for teachers to provide quality instruction.
- Delivery of instruction will be mainly through Google Classroom.
- Online videos will be used as well as textbooks for instruction.
- Teachers will be available Monday through Friday from 2:00 - 3:30 to answer questions for Distance Learners.
- Students will have to report to school for proctored tests. Teachers will set up the times when students are to report. The proctored tests will be scheduled Monday through Friday from 2:00 - 3:30. Students must provide their own transportation to and from campus.
- The same grading scale will be used for Traditional and Distance Learning students. The grading scale will be the traditional Lee County School District scale. The grading scale can be found in the student handbook.
- Distance Learning will be for a minimum of 9 weeks and must be renewed or changed at the end of each 9 week period.
- Students must log on to their Google classroom daily for attendance to be taken.
- Distance Learning students may participate in sports and extracurricular activities. The coach or director of the sport or extracurricular activity will set forth the guidelines for participation.
