# MS SCHOLARS

- MS SCHOLARS CURRICULUM CAN BE FOUND ON MHS WEBSITE UNDER THE “RESOURCES” TAB
- ATTENDANCE IS THE NUMBER ONE ELIMINATOR FOR SENIORS
- SENIORS MUST HAVE 95% SCHOOL ATTENDANCE FROM 9TH - 12TH GRADE
  - 36 MISSED DAYS TOTAL
  - A DAY MISSED, IS A DAY MISSED
  - ALL UNEXCUSED AND EXCUSED ABSENCES WILL BE COUNTED
- COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS, 18 ON THE ACT, 2.5 GPA IS REQUIRED

# SPECIAL DISTINCTION

- MUST BE INDICATED TO MRS. BOND BEFORE THE STUDENT'S JUNIOR YEAR
- THE CURRICULUM, ON THE NEXT SLIDE, IS STRAIGHT FROM THE LCSD HANDBOOK. PAGE 38
- YOU MUST COMPLETE THE CURRICULUM AND FINISH WITH A 92.5 ROUNDED TO A 93 TO QUALIFY
- MRS. BOND MUST KNOW YOU ARE ON THIS TRACK TO ASSURE YOUR SCHEDULE REFLECTS THE APPROPRIATE CLASSES

# SPECIAL DISTINCTION CURRICULUM

## Special Distinction Curriculum:

- 4 credits of English (includes at least 2 years of the following: Accelerated English, AP English, Dual Credit English Composition)
- 4 credits of math (Alg. I – 1, Geometry – 1, Algebra II – 1, Trigonometry –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Advanced Algebra –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Statistics – 1; Pre-Calculus –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Calculus – 1, AP Calculus AB - 1, Dual Credit College Algebra - 1, Dual Credit College Calculus – 1; Algebra III – 1; Advanced Math Plus - 1)
- 4 credits of social studies (Mississippi Studies –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Geography –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , World History – 1, U.S. History – 1, U.S. Government –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Economics –  $\frac{1}{2}$ , any approved AP Secondary Social Studies course)
- \*4 credits of science (Biology I, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy and Physiology, or any approved AP Secondary Science course)
- 2 credits of foreign language or advanced courses in math or science OR any Dual Credit academic course
- 1 credit of technology (Computer Discovery or Keyboarding/Computer Applications, Technology Foundations, or STEM)
- $\frac{1}{2}$  credit of Contemporary (Comprehensive) Health
- 1 credit of the Arts
- Approved Dual Credit courses may be taken as part of the Special Distinction Curriculum.

\*\*Two of the science courses must be laboratory based

# HONORS

- ANY STUDENT WHO HAS AN OVERALL AVERAGE ON ALL COURSES TAKEN OF A 89.5 ROUNDED TO A 90 WILL BE RECOGNIZED DURING THE GRADUATION CEREMONY.
- NO SPECIFIC CURRICULUM

# COLLEGE VISITS

- YOU WILL CONTINUE TO GET MESSAGES ABOUT “MISSING DOCUMENTS”
- I PROMISE, THEY WILL GET SENT IN BEFORE THE DEADLINE
- OH, DID I MENTION- YOU’LL CONTINUE TO GET MESSAGES ABOUT “MISSING DOCUMENTS” THAT THE COUNSELOR NEEDS TO SUBMIT? DISREGARD THEM

# TRANSCRIPTS

- WHEN A STUDENT APPLIES FOR ICC, THEY ARE GOING TO GET A MESSAGE THAT ASKS FOR THE STUDENT TO SUBMIT A COPY OF A TRANSCRIPT, **ICC DOES NOT WANT A COPY OF THE TRANSCRIPT UNTIL THE TRANSCRIPT IS FINALIZED IN MAY. THEREFORE, I WILL NOT SEND TRANSCRIPTS TO ICC UNTIL MAY. \*EARLY GRADUATES DO NOT FALL UNDER THIS\***
- TRANSCRIPTS ARE FREE
- MRS. NICHOLS OR THE COUNSELORS CAN GET YOU A COPY OF YOUR TRANSCRIPT OR SEND YOUR TRANSCRIPT FOR YOU.

# DUAL CREDIT CONTINUED

- WHAT IS ICC'S DISCOUNT?
  - \$100 FOR THE COURSE PLUS THE DIGITAL CONTENT FEE (THE ONLINE BOOK FEE IS NOT OPTIONAL)
- PAYMENTS FOR DUAL CREDIT COURSES WILL BE COLLECTED ASAP
- MUST MAINTAIN A "C" OR HIGHER TO QUALIFY FOR THE DISCOUNT
- STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN 15 HOURS AND NOT GO OVER FOR ICC'S DISCOUNT
